# **Application Checklist**

## 1. Application Form

Complete the online Application for Graduate Admission.

#### 2. Resume

Submit a current professional resume showing all prior work and educational experiences. You will have the opportunity to upload your resume when you complete the online application form.

## 3. Transcripts

Provide official transcripts showing all college credit attempted and/or completed from each college and university previously attended.

#### 4. MAT Statement of Goals

Complete this prompt about why you want to become a teacher.

#### 5. Letters of Recommendation

Two letters of recommendation are required. One letter from a supervisor in a professional/academic capacity and another that must exhibit evidence of experience with children/youth. Please have your evaluator fill-out this <u>template</u> or use it as a cover sheet.

#### 6. Student Teaching Background Information

Completed a <u>questionnaire</u> to help us determine if you are eligible to be placed in a classroom for student teaching.

#### 7. Note: Licensure Tests

If you are accepted to the MAT program, you will be conditionally admitted pending successful completion of all required licensure tests by June 1. Please review <u>this document</u> for detailed information.
