Testing Requirements

- Candidates seeking licensure with an <u>elementary focus (grades K-5)</u> must complete and pass the <u>Elementary Education Subtests I and II.</u>

- Candidates seeking licensure with a <u>secondary focus (grades 6-12)</u> must complete and pass the ORELA Subject Area test in the area(s) he/she wishes to teach.

- <u>All candidates</u> must complete and pass the <u>Protecting Student and Civil Rights in the Educational Environment test.</u>

No MAT candidate will be permitted to begin clinical experience in the Fall (second) semester of the program until all testing requirements are complete.
