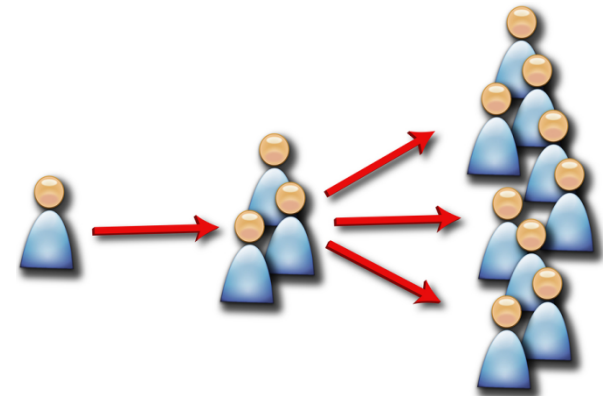
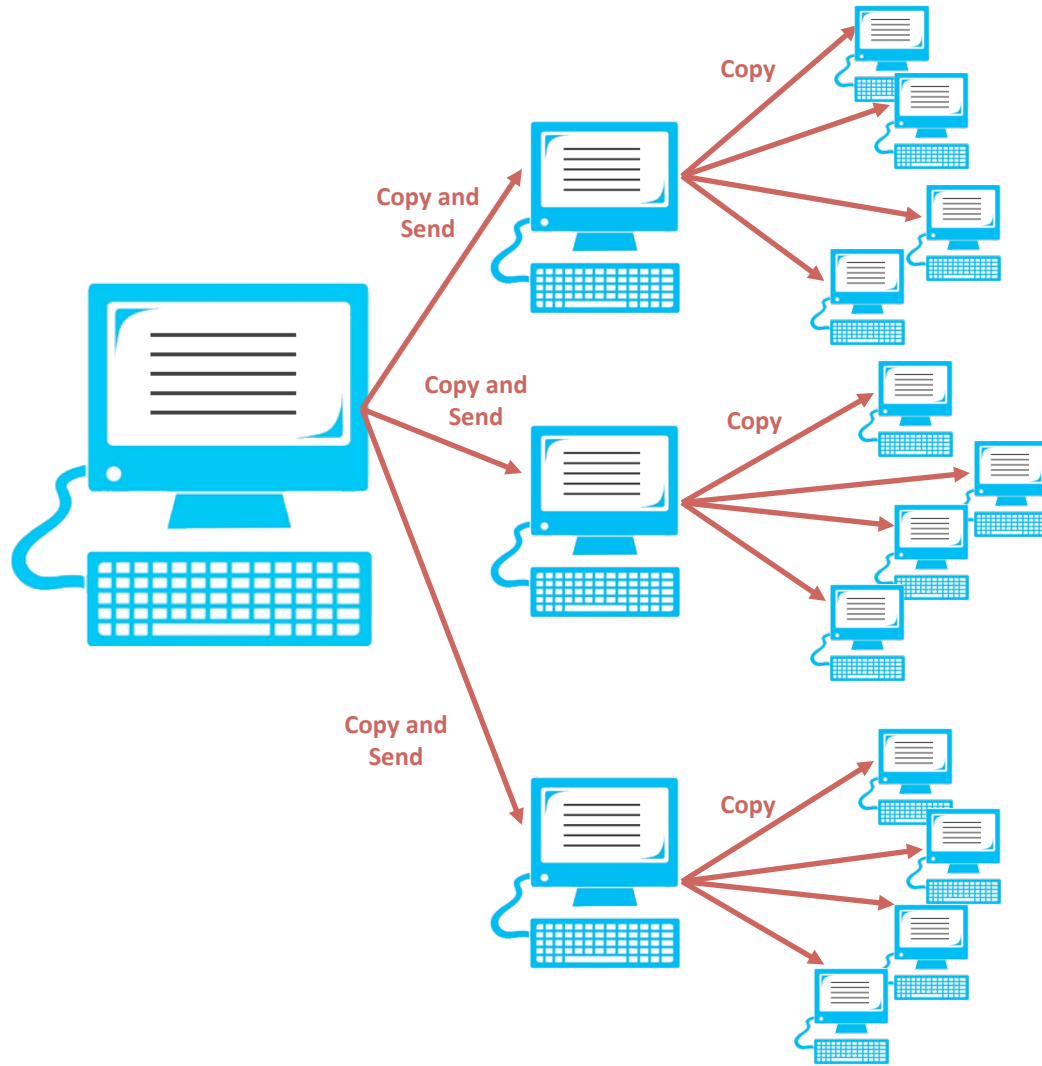
- It is an electronic means of hurting others using the internet and cell phones
